



Dear Families,

We have great news about school meals! Bishop Garrigan and Seton are excited to announce that we have been approved to offer FREE MEALS TO ALL STUDENTS.

Who can get free meals?

Any student, whether they are doing in-person learning at school or virtual/remote learning at home, can get free meals. Free meals are not available to children 18 years & younger who are not enrolled at Bishop Garrigan or Seton. This includes younger children who are not in school yet, children enrolled in other schools and children who are homeschooled.

When does this start?

Free meals are available on Monday, September 28th, 2020.

Where are the free meals available?

The meals will be available at the Bishop Garrigan and Seton cafeterias during your student's normal lunch time and those who are learning from home who have signed up.

What is being served?

The free breakfast and lunch being served will be what is posted on our monthly breakfast and lunch menu. Please keep in mind that if your student wants an extra item, you will be charged regular price for that. For example, if you student gets an extra milk or takes an extra main course, you will be charged accordingly.

How long will free meals last?

The free meal program will last until December 31st, 2020 or until funds run out.
