Dress Code/Grooming

- Undershirts - Students may wear long or short sleeved undershirts. (white, yellow/gold, black, or gray)
- Boys must be clean shaven
- Tattoos must be covered at all times. This includes activities and academics.
- Bishop Garrigan recognizes that there are different types of hair, and that no single set of descriptions will perfectly capture the school's expectations about haircuts, but the following guidelines will keep a student in compliance with the school's expectations. Students should maintain a professional haircut. This includes but is not limited to: Students are permitted to dye, tint, color, or highlight their hair, provided that the color is consistent with a natural hair color. Extreme colors or distracting hairstyles are not acceptable. Boys' hair is not to extend over the top of the ear, eyebrows, or below the natural hairline. Sideburns may not extend lower than the middle of the ear, and must be neatly groomed.
- Out of Uniform Days - On designated days the student body may wear their choice of clothing. Shirts that have inappropriate sayings, and exhibit drug or sex slogans are not allowed. Students may not wear jeans with holes or that are ripped. Appropriate dress is always the rule of the day. Appropriate dress will be determined as needed by the principal or president. Students in grades K-8 may only wear uniform shorts on these days. Shorts and dresses must at least touch the fingertips. No hats of any kind.

Academics (9-12)

- Midterms - At 2nd, 3rd and 4th quarter midterms (progress reports): If a student receives 1 F or 2 or more D slips, that student must attend 2 study sessions supervised by teachers (Tuesdays and Wednesdays 7:15 - 8:00). This includes all activities. If they are not in any activities they still must attend the study sessions. If you are late or miss the study session, you are not allowed to practice that night.
- At quarter break: If a student receives 1 F or 2 or more D slips (any kind) or has a grade point of 1.5 or below they are ineligible for one week's activities (not to exceed 2 activities).
- Semester - If a student receives 1 F at semester they must sit 30 days of the next sport in which they participate.

Cheating

The student may be allowed to make up the work outside of school time within three days, but with a substantially lowered maximum score. After three days no make-up will be allowed, and the grade will be zero.

Service Hours

Students should enter service hours every quarter. These hours are used for various reasons throughout their high school career. Hours can be entered as they are completed by using the Bishop Garrigan website.
